TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION'S DISQUALIFYING CRIMES

1. Forgery of certificates, false marking of aircraft, and other aircraft registration violations, 49 U.S.C. 46306;
2. Interference with air navigation, 49 U.S.C. 46308;
3. Improper transportation of a hazardous material, 49 U.S.C. 46312;

5. Interference with flight crew members or flight attendants, 49 U.S.C. 46504;

9. Aircraft piracy outside the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States, 49 U.S.C. 46502(b);
10. Lighting violations involving transporting controlled substances, 49 U.S.C. 46315;
11. Unlawful entry into an aircraft or airport area that serves air carriers or foreign air carriers contrary to established security requirements, 49 U.S.C. 46314;
12. Destruction of an aircraft or aircraft facility, 18 U.S.C. 32;
13. Murder;
14. Assault with intent to murder;
15. Espionage;
16. Sedition;
17. Kidnapping or hostage taking;
18. Treason;
19. Rape or aggravated sexual abuse;
20. Unlawful possession, use, sale, distribution, or manufacture of an explosive or weapon;
21. Extortion;
22. Armed robbery or felony unarmed robbery;
23. Distribution of, or intent to distribute, a controlled substance;
24. Felony arson;
25. A Felony involving a threat.
26. A Felony involving -
 - a. Willful destruction of property;
 - b. Importation or manufacture of a controlled substance;
 - c. Dishonesty, fraud, or misrepresentation;
 - d. Possession or distribution of stolen property;
 - e. Illegal possession of a controlled substance punishable by a maximum term of imprisonment of more than 1 year, or any other crime classified as a felony that the Administrator determines indicates a propensity for lacing contraband aboard an aircraft in return for money;
 - f. Burglary;
 - g. Theft;
 - h. Aggravated assault;
 - i. Bribery.
27. Violence at international airports; 18 U.S.C. 37.
28. Conspiracy or attempt to commit any of the aforementioned criminal acts.

By signing this application, I hereby state that I have never been convicted, or found not guilty of by reason of insanity, of any of the disqualifying crimes listed above in any jurisdiction during the past 10 years from the date of this application.

I understand that Federal regulations under 49 CFR 1542.209 (l) impose a continuing obligation to disclose to the airport operator within 24 hours if I am convicted of any disqualifying criminal offense that occurs while I have unescorted access authority.

I understand and agree to comply with the terms and conditions provided for in the CHRC and agree to comply with any changes or amendments to the terms and conditions that may be imposed by SRQ or the TSA. The information that I have provided on this application is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and is provided in good faith. I understand that a knowing and willful false statement on this application can be punished by fine or imprisonment or both. (See section 1001 of Title 18 United States Code; Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Sections 1540.103 and 1542.209) I further understand that a knowing and willful false statement on this application will result in disqualification of access to the secure areas of the airport.
